Preferred applicants will hold a valid A&P license and have been carded or eligible to be carded for fire suppression work in the state of Alaska with an AS350B3.

The ideal candidate has:

- A valid A&P License for a minimum of 24 months.
- Been actively involved in aircraft maintenance for 12 of the preceding 24 months.
- 12 months total experience maintaining the AS350B3, or
- Taken a manufacturers maintenance course or an equivalent contractor's course for AS350B3.
- At least three consecutive months maintaining the helicopter away from employer's base of operation and with minimal supervision.
